Ties will be shoot off last man standing.

N.S.S.A. Rules will apply to all targets shot. These events will be shot all targets of one event on one field.

Registration Fees include N.S.S.A. fees and W.S.S.A. daily fees. Events will close one-half hour before the last flight time.

Squads will not be called. Reasonable delays will be allowed. (5 minutes)

All ties will be shot off. Doubles 3, 4, & 5 (Total by Station).

All team shootoffs will be shot off last person standing doubles 3-4-5 (Total by Station)

Payment of all money awards will be made by one check and mailed to the contestants.

Reloads permitted subject to N.S.S.A. 1B-2.

Contestants and spectators assume all risks resulting from accidents occurring on the grounds.

Ammunition will be available at the club.

The club will be open Wednesday April 27th 3p.m. for practice and Thursday April 28th 3p.m for early registration and practice. Early registration is encouraged. Practice rounds are \$4.50 for targets.

The Management reserves the right to modify or change this program or reject any entry considered a detriment to the harmony of the tournament.

Special Spokane Gun Club awards will be presented to shooters who registered their first 100-straight score on the Spokane Gun Club Ranges.
