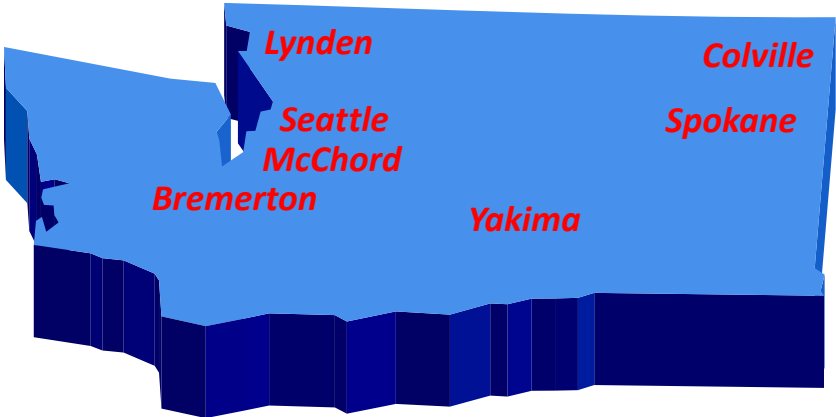

Washington Skeet Shooting Association

History

First a little background on how skeet shooting got started. In 1920 a group of upland game hunters invented the sport at Glen Rock Kennels in Andover Massachusetts to improve their hunting skills. Their using the range for practice soon developed into competition. The original layout was in the round but it was soon realized that in the round needed exceptional land and caused safety problems. Hence the half circle and current shooting stations for skeet today. The name "Skeet" comes from a Scandinavian word meaning shoot. The sport was named by Gertrude Hurlbut in 1926 who lived in Dayton Montana in a contest to name the sport by the fledgling national skeet organization. She won \$100.00. Over 10,000 suggested names were sent in. Also in 1926, the sport as we know it today was introduced. One of the first rule books published was one half of one page. World Championships are held each year in San Antonio Texas in October. The Olympics recognized skeet as an Olympic sport in 1968.

Skeet in Washington State can trace its roots back into the 1920s when a picture of shooting skeet appeared at a club somewhere in Bremerton dated 1927. Other clubs soon followed. Gun clubs, Seattle, Spokane, Bremerton and many other still active in skeet shooting today, can look way back, some to the late 1800s. Till skeet became a recognized sport in 1926, all were trap clubs. Due to many circumstances, usually encroachment from nearby building, many clubs have moved from their original locations, sometimes more than once.

Washington State Skeet Championships have been held since 1935, which also coincides with the first world championships held in Cleveland Ohio that year. The first listed Washington champions were Joe Warren and L T Beuhz shooting at Tacoma. Over the years state shoots have been shot at, Bremerton, Lynden, Wenatchee, Fort Lewis, Seattle, Spokane, Waterville and Tacoma.

The Washington Skeet Shooting Association as we know it today was formed on December 7, 1967 at a meeting held in the Seattle area. Phil Giger, from Spokane, was instrumental in the formation of the association and was elected its first president, serving two terms. The first set of bylaws were put together and financial footing established for the association. The first Vice President was Relon Lore and Secretary /Treasure Elaine Gregg.

The first state championships under the new associations banner was held in 1969 at Spokane with Hal Huskinson the first HOA Champion. To date as far as records can be researched, 107 shooters have won 353 state championships. The current record holders are Alden Hansen shooting in the 60s and Jeff VanDenTop who both have 18 state championships, either gun or HOA.

Today clubs active in registered skeet shooting in Washington State are Spokane, Lynden, Bremerton, McChord, Seattle, Colville and Sun Valley. These clubs provide about 20 shoots per year for the shooters to attend and enjoy competition.

This year's championships being held at Lynden Shotgun Club will be 72nd held since 1935. There were no state championships during the WWII years of 1943 to 1947. This year's championship under the WSSA banner will be the association's 43rd.

Hosts

This tournament is hosted by Lynden Shotgun Club

Rules

2011 NSSA rules apply to all aspects of this tournament.

Risks

Contestants and spectators assume all risks while on club grounds.

Ammunition

Shooters will provide their own proof ammunition.

Reloaded ammunition which complies with Rule 1-B-2 is allowed.

New ammunition will be available for purchase.

Targets

Orange Dome White Flyer targets will be thrown.

Machine Adjustments

All machine adjustments will be hooped, no exceptions.

Shootoffs

Shootoffs for all events and ties will be doubles at stations 3, 4 and 5, total by station. All team shootoffs will be last person standing.

Cash Payouts

Cash payouts will be paid by check sent to the address on your entry form.

Event Entries

Event entries close one-half hour before the last flight time.

Classification Cards

Classification cards must be up to date prior to registration. All shooters must present their classification card at registration or be declared AA.

Please visit myNSSA.com if you need data on your shoot history.

HOA or HAA Class

No shooters HOA or HAA class may be lower than their lowest gun class.

Food

Breakfast and lunch will be available at the club.

Breakfast 7:00 am - 10:30 pm Lunch 11:30 am to 2:00 pm.

Weather

This tournament will be held regardless of weather. In the event of extreme weather conditions, the chief referee will rule on delays or cancellations.

Perpetual trophies will be presented to all event champions, High All-Around Champion, Champ of Champs champion and all concurrent HOA winners.

Award Presentations

All awards for Friday and Saturdays events, except the champions medallions, will be presented at the State Shoot Banquet Saturday evening. Sundays awards will be presented as soon as shootoffs and necessary paper work are completed.

Champion Medallions

An Olympic style awards ceremony will take place each day with a gold & silver medallion placed around the neck of the Champion, Champion RU of each event.

On Friday, July 22nd medallions for the Doubles will be awarded immediately after the shootoffs.

On Saturday, July 23rd the ceremony for 12 Gauge and 28 Gauge will take place immediately following completion of shoot-offs.

On Sunday, July 24th the ceremony for 20 Gauge .410 Bore and HOA will take place at the final awards presentation.

HOA 1st & RU will receive a medallion in addition to their other award at the Sunday awards presentation.

We ask that all medallion winners be present daily, and stay Sunday afternoon for pictures on the podium.

100 Straight Pins

Shooters shooting their first 100 straight at a State Championships will receive a pin for the gauge: 12, 20, 28, 410 and doubles. One pin per shooter.

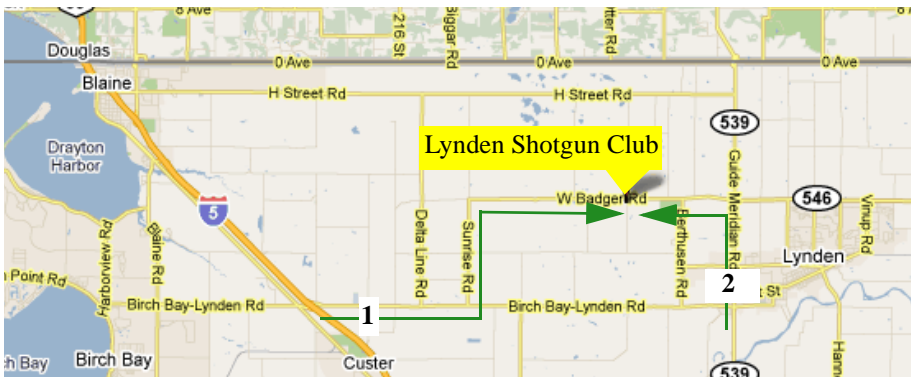
