- 1) All the above information must be filled out. If any information is missing a pass cannot be issued.
- 2) DFMWR and the Security police at JBLM require a minimum of three weeks to process the paperwork for any event. If you are not registered and have this request turned in by three weeks prior to the event, you will not be able to obtain a pass.
- 3) Please note that you middle name must be in full. Please no initials or nick names.
- 4) If the pass is issued, you do not need to go through the visitors center. the pass will allow you to go straight to the gate.
- 5) The driver must show his pass to the gate guard along with his drivers license, Insurance and state registration.
- 6) All persons in the vehicle 16 years of age or older must have a special event pass. and a picture ID.
- 7) Note; Security policy requires all foreign nationals (non US Citizens) to obtain a visitors pass in person in the company of an authorized sponsor (DOD Id card holder)
- 8) Note; Gun registration is only required for those personnel residing on JBLM in accordance with JBLM reg. 190-11 Personnel are responsible for ensuring that guns being transported are NOT LOADED and in a soft or hard gun case. Ammunition will be stored separately and both items must be out of arm's reach.(e.g. trunk, back seat, etc.)

- 9) If you have a carry permit, please be advised that the security police will not recognize it and may confiscate your fire arm. Please leave all hand guns at home.
