This year's **Ironman** will be **ONE** event consisting of 400 12 Gauge targets shot using **12 Gauge gun and 12 Gauge ammo only**. The program consists of 200 targets shot

each day, 100 targets in AM and 2<sup>nd</sup> 100 targets in the PM. You may shoot less than 400 as 12 ga targets only \$36/100.

Event #1 Rotation 1: 9:30, 12:30 Rotation 2: 11:00, 2:00 Sunday: 11:00, 2:00; 9:30; 12:30

Event #2 Ironman Options (200s) \$12: 200s are 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> 100s, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> 100s, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> 100s, based on 12

Ga class. High score by class wins, ties split.

To accommodate additional shooters, a 3<sup>rd</sup> rotation may be added; therefore, **PREREGISTRATION IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED!!** \* Otherwise, plan on the 9:30 start time

**Entry fee**: \$165, includes fees. \$20 of each entry will be returned to class. Payout will be 100% 1-4 in class, 5 or more in class will split 60-40, 9 or more will split 50/30/20. Champion takes class money plus \$10 of each entry. All ties will be decided by Doubles at 3-4-5 total by station. Checks will be mailed. Honorary concurrents.

- 1) Club will open at 8:00 AM
- 2) Current NSSA rules apply. All shoot offs will be doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5.
- 3) Shoot management reserves the right to modify the program as necessary. Changes will be posted at registration.
- 4) Please have your current, updated 2023 NSSA classification card. This is available at nssansca.org/skeet/member-login.
- 5) Canteberry Voice Call system will be used. Shooters may be asked to keep score.
- 6) Due to nationwide shortage, shooters must provide their own ammunition to include proof shells. PLEASE use #9 shot for all events, at least 100 targets each day will be shot on Field 2 which requires #9 shot.
- 7) Lunch will be available at the club or if you prefer local fast food facilities are within 1 2 blocks of club. \*\*
- 8) The club assumes no liability in cases of theft or injuries while on JBLM McChord Field.
- \*BASE PASS & PREREGISTRATION: All non-DOD shooters and their guests need a pass to enter JBLM McChord Field.
