Champion collects class fees and \$6.00 per entry. All ties resolved by doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5 (total by station). Winners will receive payouts via mailed check. Concurrents: Honors Only.

- 1. Club will open at 8:00 AM
- 2. Current NSSA rules apply. Shoot offs will be determined by doubles at stations 3, 4, and 5.
- 3. Shoot management reserves the right to modify the program, as necessary. Any changes will be posted at registration.
- 4. Please have your current, updated 2025 NSSA classification card available. See nssa-nsca.org/skeet/memberlogin and print and bring your scores.
- 5. Canteberry Voice Call system may be used and shooters may be asked to keep score.
- 6. Shooters must provide their own ammunition to include proof shells. PLEASE use #9 shot for all events.
- 7. Lunch will be available at local fast-food facilities within 1 2 blocks of club. Beverages and light snacks will be available at the club. Fast Food options: Burger King, Food Court in the Main Exchange 1 ½ blocks north of the club, and the Golf Course offers lunch options. (Turn left at traffic light by Burger King and club house is on right immediately past the golf course).
